


## Make Bunny Ears & Act Like the Rabbit

<p><b>1. Gather your materials.</b></p> <p>You will need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 pieces of paper</li> <li>• Scissors</li> <li>• Tape</li> <li>• Stickers, crayons, and markers</li> </ul>	
<p><b>2. Make the head band.</b></p> <p>Measure the circumference of your child's head using a piece of paper.</p> <p>You may need to tape two pieces of paper together. Cut the paper so that it is only about 1-2 inches high. Don't close the loop just yet.</p>	
<p><b>3. Make the 'ears'.</b></p> <p>On a different piece of paper, draw the outline of two tall ears.</p> <p>If your child is old enough to use kid safe scissors, ask them to cut out the shapes. Otherwise, do it yourself.</p>	
<p><b>4. Put the bunny ears together and decorate.</b></p> <p>Tape the ears to the inside the band you cut in step 1.</p> <p>Lay the band and ears flat on the table.</p> <p>Ask your child to decorate the bunny ears with markers, crayons, and stickers.</p>	
<p><b>5. Act like the Rabbit!</b></p> <p>Tape the band closed.</p> <p>Place the bunny ears on your child's head.</p> <p>Encourage your child to act like a rabbit by jumping, twitching their nose, and most IMPORTANTLY, by listening and being kind!</p>
