## Make Bunny Ears & Act Like the Rabbit

<ul> <li>1. Gather your materials.</li> <li>You will need: <ul> <li>2 pieces of paper</li> <li>Scissors</li> <li>Tape</li> <li>Stickers, crayons, and markers</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>2. Make the head band.</li> <li>Measure the circumference of your child's head using a piece of paper.</li> <li>You may need to tape two pieces of paper together. Cut the paper so that it is only about 1-2 inches high. Don't close the loop just yet.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>3. Make the 'ears'.</li> <li>On a different piece of paper, draw the outline of two tall ears.</li> <li>If your child is old enough to use kid safe scissors, ask them to cut out the shapes.</li> <li>Otherwise, do it yourself.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li><b>4. Put the bunny ears together and decorate.</b></li> <li>Tape the ears to the inside the band you cut in step 1.</li> <li>Lay the band and ears flat on the table.</li> <li>Ask your child to decorate the bunny ears with markers, crayons, and stickers.</li> </ul>	
<b>5. Act like the Rabbit!</b> Tape the band closed. Place the bunny ears on your child's head. Encourage your child to act like a rabbit by jumping, twitching their nose, and most IMPORTANTLY, by listening and being kind!
